

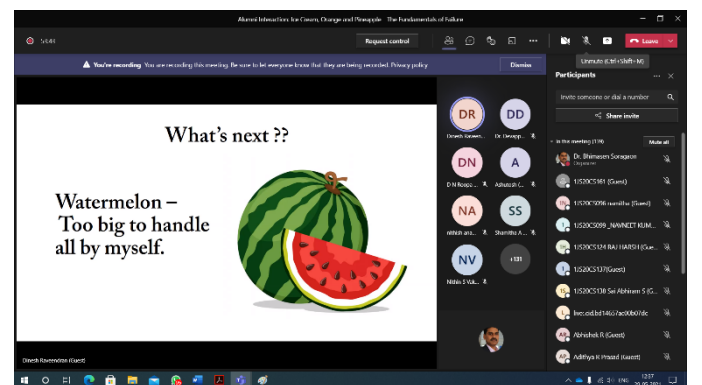
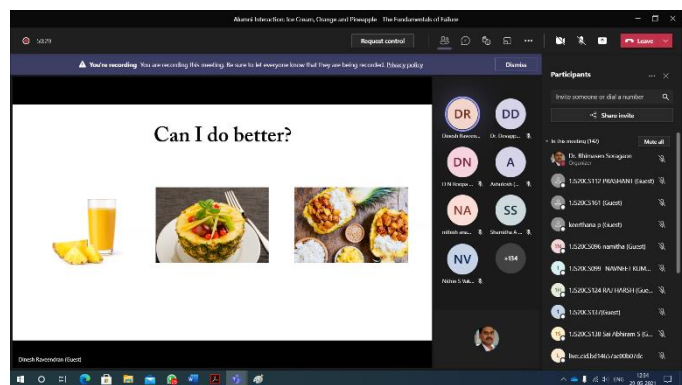
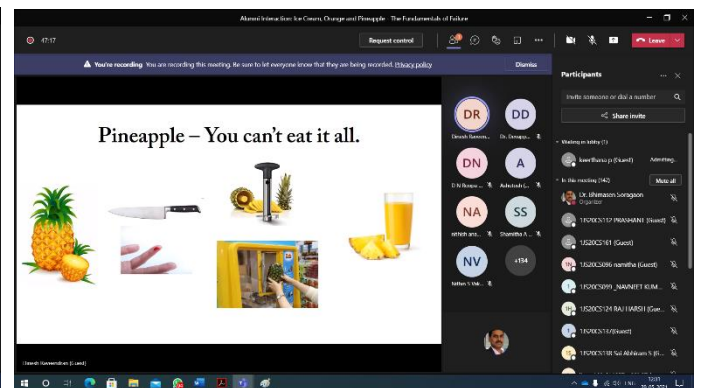
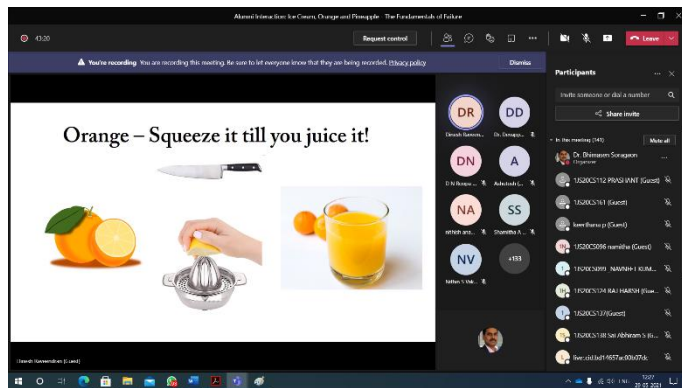
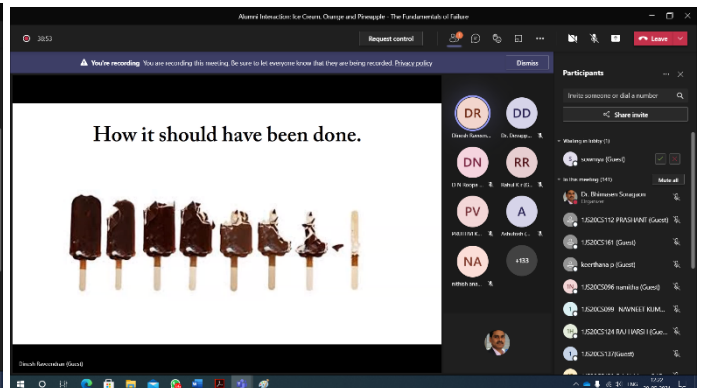
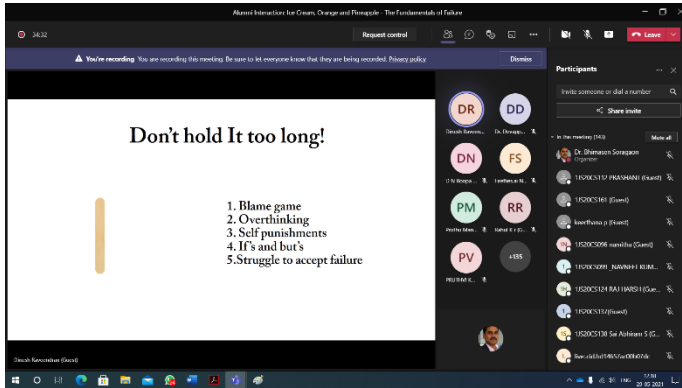
A Report on Alumni Interaction

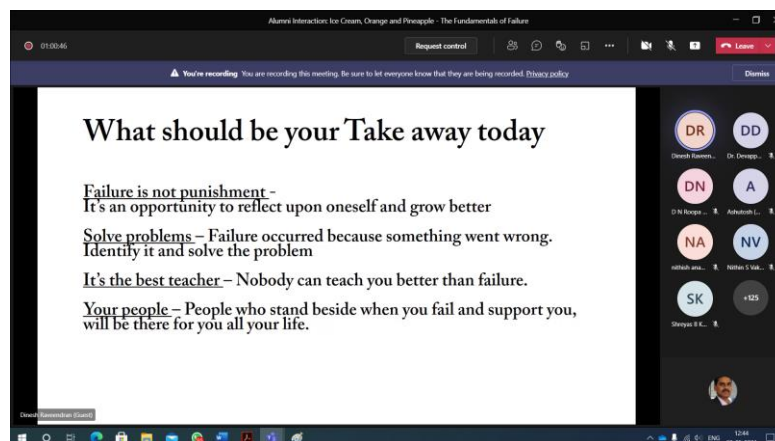
